Modeling is crucial for children to develop their receptive language. A child is more likely to understand a direction if a caregiver models the behavior first. Modeling is when a caregiver physically shows an action while verbalizing. It means to demonstrate.

For instance, the caregiver would say, "I am throwing a ball" while modeling the motion of throwing the ball. It is important to show the action before expecting the child to do it.

Speech language therapists use modeling technique to aid the language development of a child.

Modeling can also be used by parents. During play, car trips and around the house too!
