Skills for living and learning:

The purpose of our pediatric occupational therapy is to enable people to participate in daily activities (or occupations) to improve their health, independence and wellbeing. Occupations for children or young people may include self-care (dressing, eating a meal, using the toilet, making a simple meal), being productive (participating in activities and routines at nursery), and leisure (playing with friends, doing sports or hobbies). Occupational therapists can help babies, children and young people who may need support and advice if they are not able to do daily occupations due to illness, disability, family circumstances, or as a result of changes as they get older.

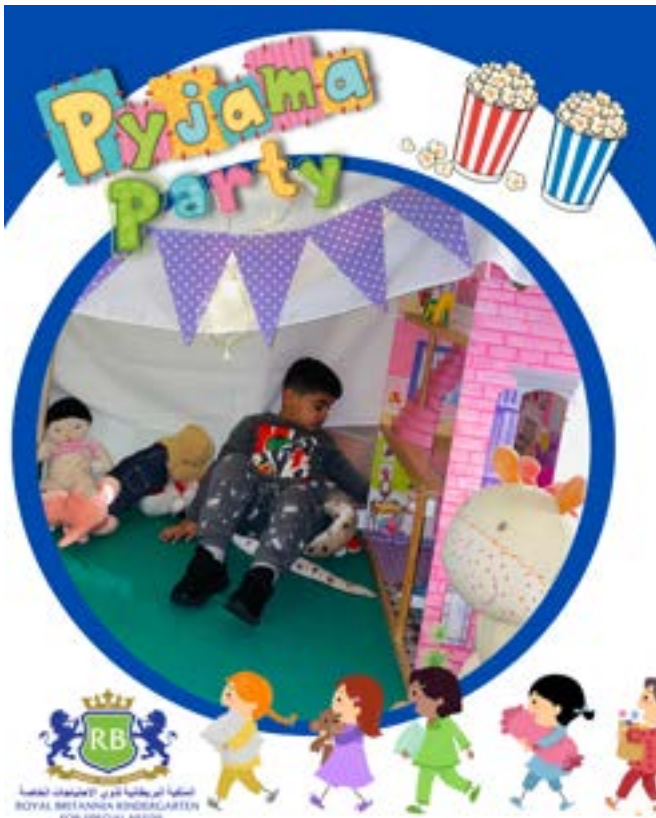

I'M LEARNING TO...

LITERACY

Transportation

Identifying different modes of transportation and the vehicles used for each mode, uniqueness and similarity of the different vehicles.

T: Explore and respond to different natural phenomena in their setting and on trips.

When teaching letters/sounds keep in mind:

Letter recognition

Letter position

(Ending, beginning sound, circle or write the letter/sound c,k)

Revision

Letters/Sounds s,a,t,i,p,n

High ability:

Phonics Group 1: s,a,t,i,p, n and c, k, ck

Beginning/Ending sounds. CVC words.

Pre-writing

- Enjoy drawing freely.
- Add some marks to their drawings, which they give meaning to.

NUMERACY

Colour: Brown

Shape: Diamond

Numeric: Number 7

- Identify, represent, order, and write number 7
- Rote counting to 50

T: Compare sizes, weights etc. using gesture and language – 'bigger, little, smaller, heavy, high, low'.

Physical Education

Moving and Handling Health and Self-Care

- Increasingly be able to use and remember sequences and patterns of movements which are related to music and rhythm.
- Start eating independently and learning how to use a knife and fork.

Personal Social & Emotional Development

- Develop friendship with other children.
- Safely explore emotions beyond their normal range through play and stories

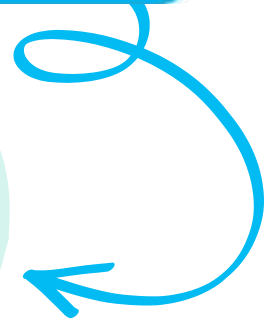


WHAT IS B1G1?
