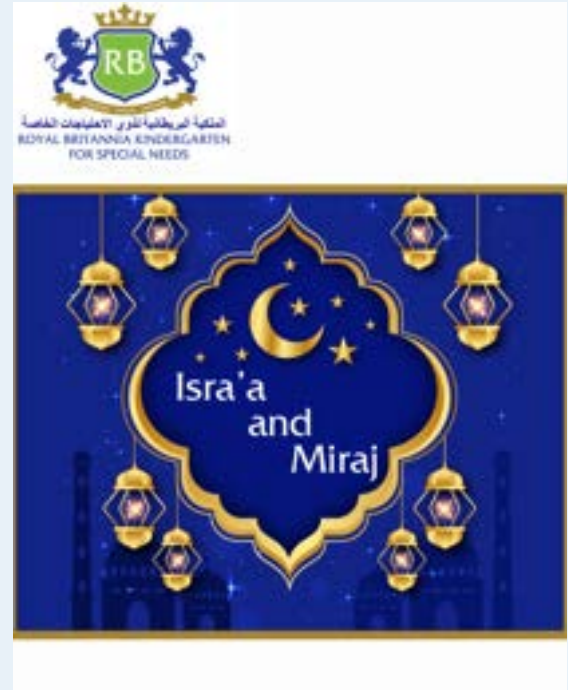

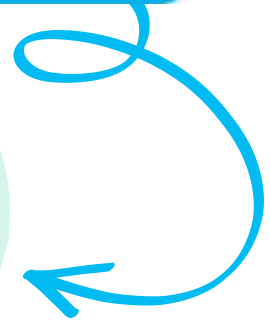


WHAT IS B1G1?
