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Speech Therapy



As a Speech and Language Therapist, I do my best to know your child: their preferred learning styles, how they handle problems, their struggles and help them to overcome the challenges of transferring the response from the restricted session setting to the child's natural environment. That's why parental involvement is crucial to maximise a child's development.

Speech therapists only have a limited time with your child every week. Whether a child is learning to pronounce a letter or sound, improve their voice characteristics or comprehension, teaching must be practiced and reinforced routinely. Parents have the advantage of spending much more time with their children. And considering children learn to communicate during everyday activities and conversations, no one is better positioned to do that than the child's parents.

Tips to help parents to improve their child's verbal communication:

- Use gestures and signs with the child
- Copy the child's sounds and words back to them
- Observe and listen to the child while they are playing
- Wait and pause for a response when playing together
- Give the child time to make a choice or a request
- Add simple commentary instead of asking questions
- Use photos and pictures
- Sing songs and look at books together
- Follow the child's lead
- Praise any attempts the child makes to communicate

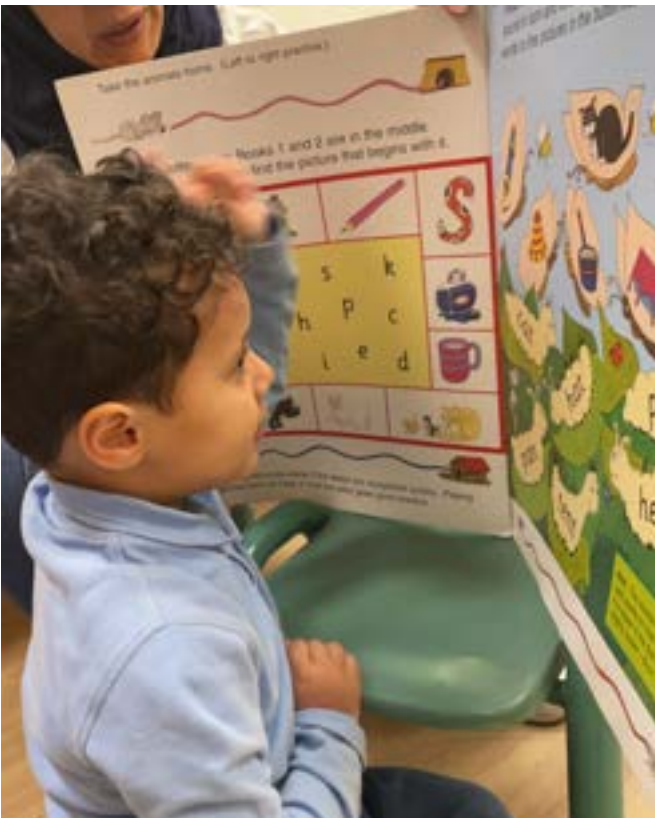

T: Create closed shapes with continuous lines and begin to use these shapes to represent objects.

- Go up steps and stairs, or climb apparatus, using alternate feet.
- Learn to use the toilet with help, and then independently.

Personal Social & Emotional Development

- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community.
- Become more outgoing with unfamiliar people, in the safe context of their setting.

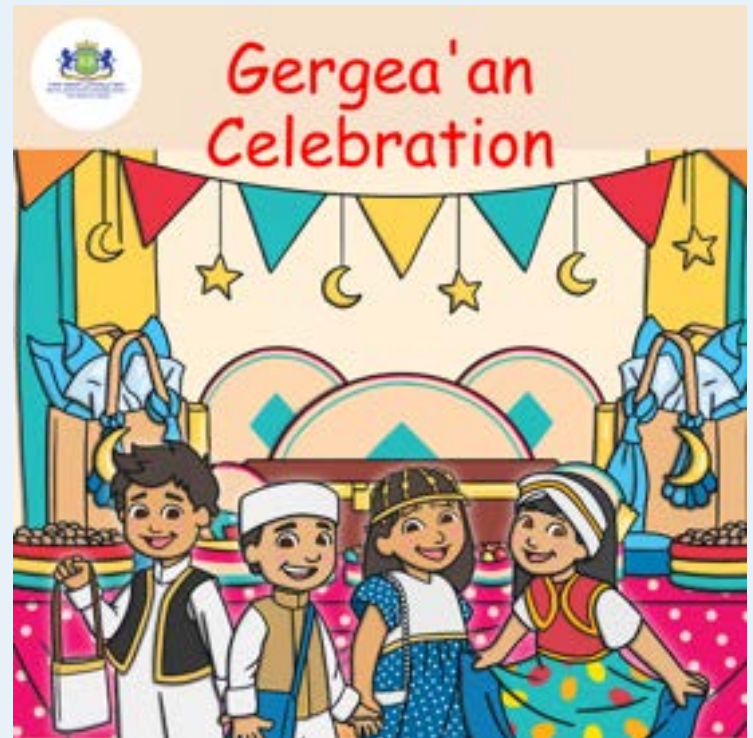

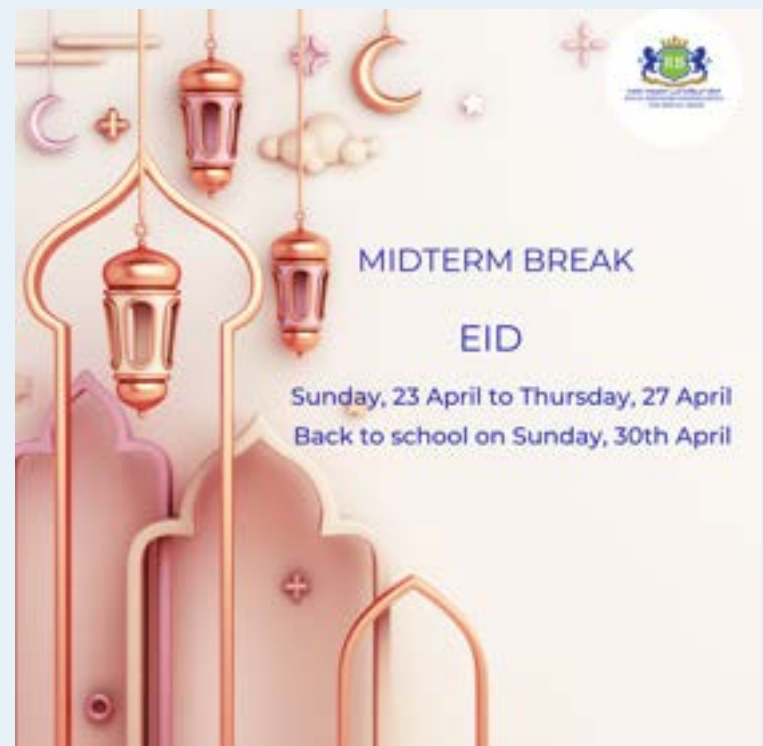

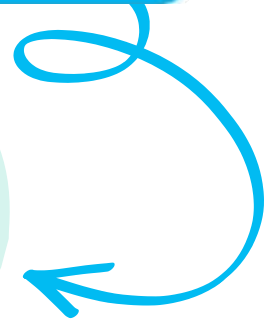


WHAT IS B1G1?
