Page 1 – Science experiment. Density.

Activity 2 – Planting seeds.

Materials needed - egg cartons, soil (cotton) and seeds.

For very young children, it is **best** to use large **seeds**, which are easy for them to handle. Suitable examples are peas, beans, sunflower and lentils. Other **seeds** that are good for **growing** in the **classroom** and using in investigations include mustard, cress, mung bean and wheat.



TOPIC
